

OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject:- The Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement (Tamil Nadu Amendment) Bill, 2014- reserved for the consideration of the President- regarding

The undersigned is directed to forward herewith a copy each of the Bill as introduced and Bill as passed by the State Legislature of Tamil Nadu and forwarding letter received from the State Government on the above mentioned subject for comments.

2. As per the Cabinet Guidelines for disposal of State Legislative proposals, the Ministries/Departments may examine the Bill and make observations within a period of six weeks in respect of the following:-

- (a) whether the proposed legislation is Constitutionally valid; or
- (b) whether there is any conflict with an existing Central Law, and, if so, whether the conflict may be consciously permitted; or
- (c) whether the proposed State enactment involves any deviation from existing national or Central policy to its detriment, or would be a hindrance to enactment of uniform laws for the country.

This Ministry may also be advised whether the assent of the President may be accorded to the Bill under article 201 of the Constitution of India.

3. It may be noted that according to the Cabinet guidelines, if the views of the Ministries/Departments are not received within six weeks, the Bill would be processed without waiting further for comments. The onus of any inconsistency, if noticed at a later stage, lies with the concerned Ministry/Department.

4. The Ministry of Law & Justice (Department of Legal Affairs) is consulted by the Ministry of Home Affairs after receipt of views/comments on the Bill from the concerned Ministries/Departments and hence requisite comments may be sent without waiting for the views, if sought for, of the Ministry of Law.
